

**Fall 2009 Mgmt 101 Enrollment and Permit Policy**  
**(reissued April 29, 2009)**

Currently, all recitations in Mgmt 101 for Fall 2009 are limited to two seniors (that is, current juniors who will be seniors in Fall 2009) in the section. This is because it is a core course which is intended for sophomores and juniors. We do not anticipate restricting senior seats in Spring 2010.

Requests for permits should be made via e-mail to [mgmt-courseinfo@wharton.upenn.edu](mailto:mgmt-courseinfo@wharton.upenn.edu) and postmarked no earlier than 8:00 am on Tuesday, September 2. Permits are limited to recitations with special restrictions (such as honors section or limitations on senior enrollment) where there are fewer than 25 students enrolled. Therefore, students are encouraged to check Penn-in-Touch during the summer and the start of the fall semester to add through the typical automated channels rather than relying solely on the possibility of a permit, as seats occasionally open when previously enrolled students drop the course, and senior quotas may be relaxed. Permit requests should include the reason(s) why you must take Mgmt 101 in the fall semester, should note whether you have any special status (such as Joseph Wharton Scholar, Ben Franklin Scholar, Management and Technology Program, Huntsman Program, or Mgmt 100 TA).
